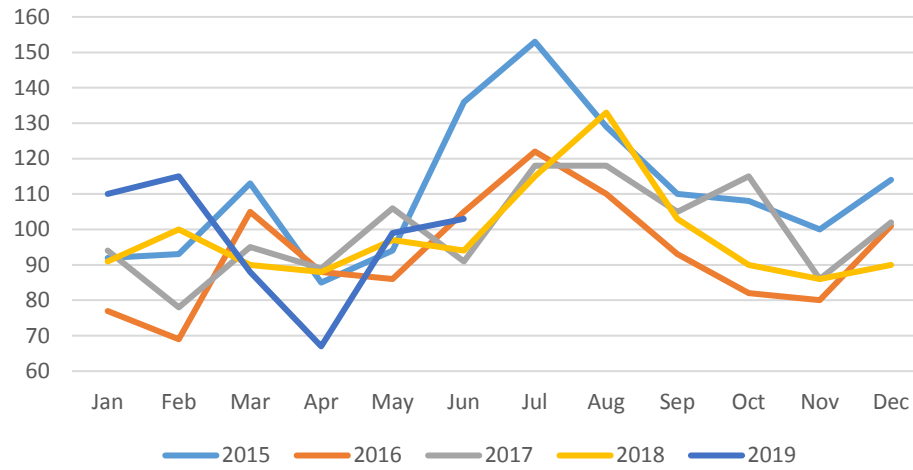

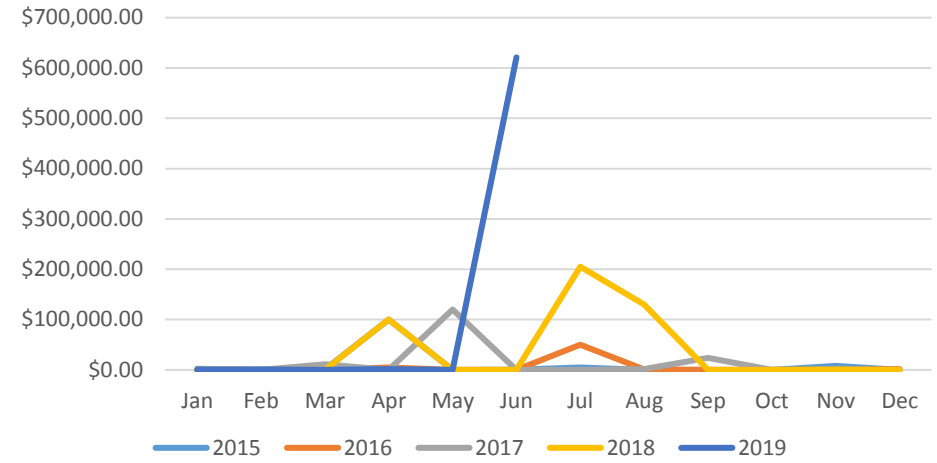

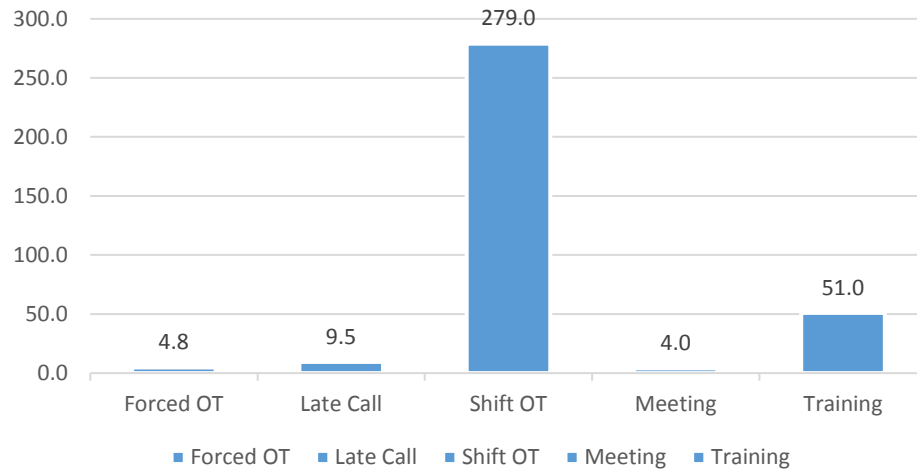
Incident Volume By Month



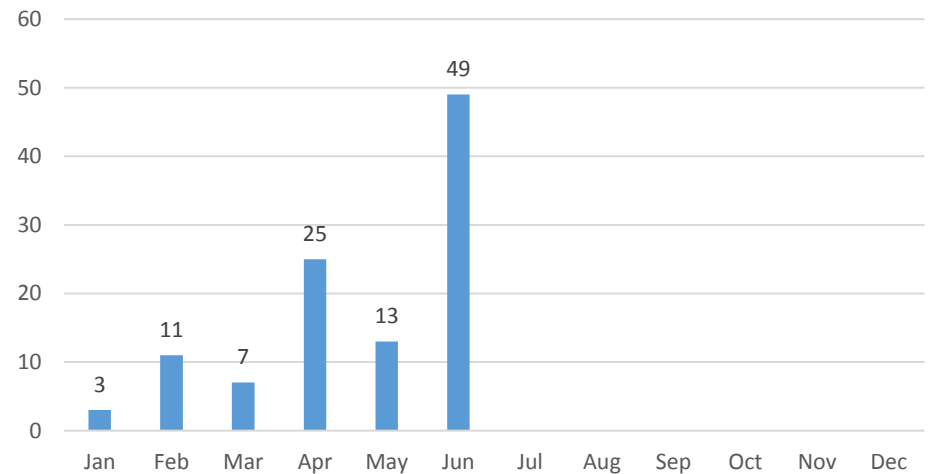
Fire Loss by Month and Year



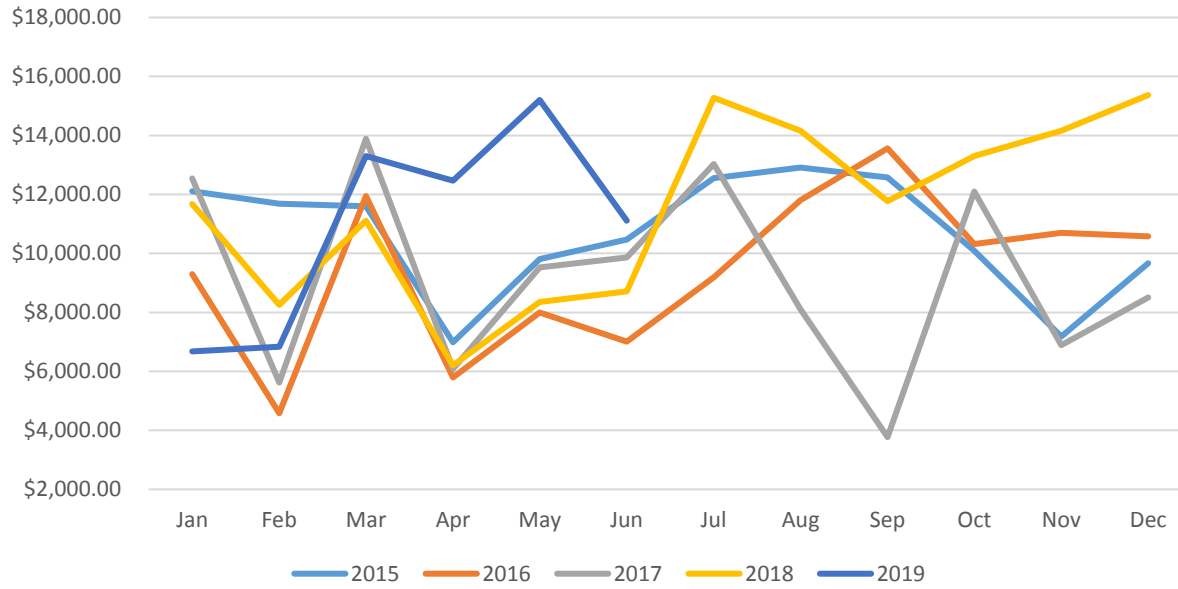
STAFF OVERTIME - June 2019



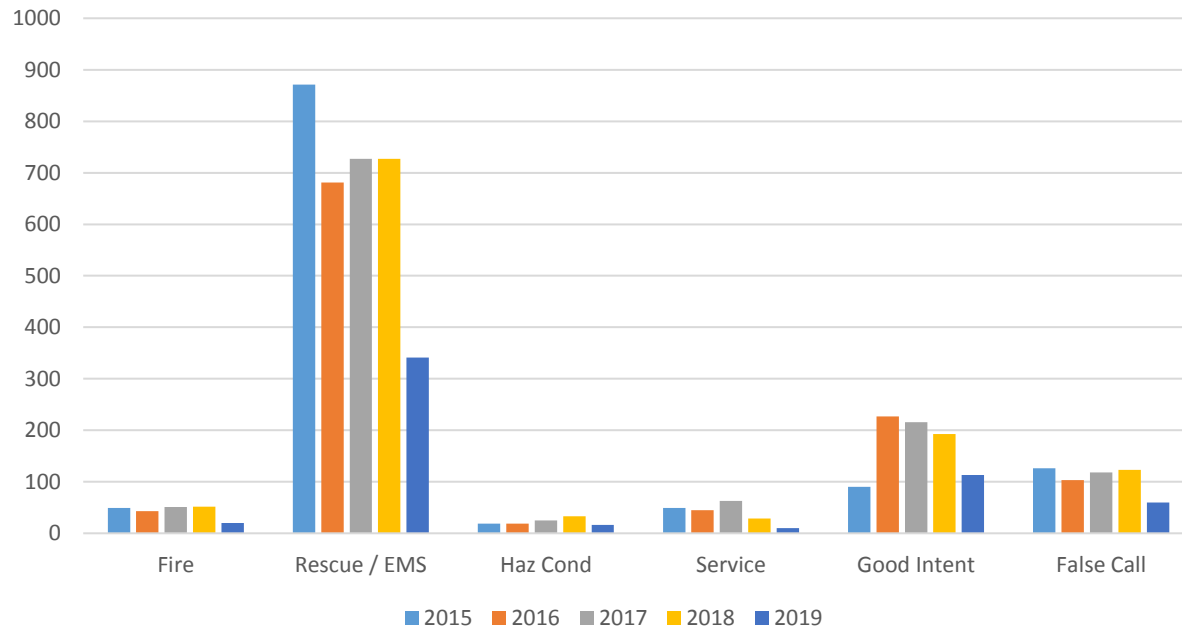
Fire Safety Inspections - 2019



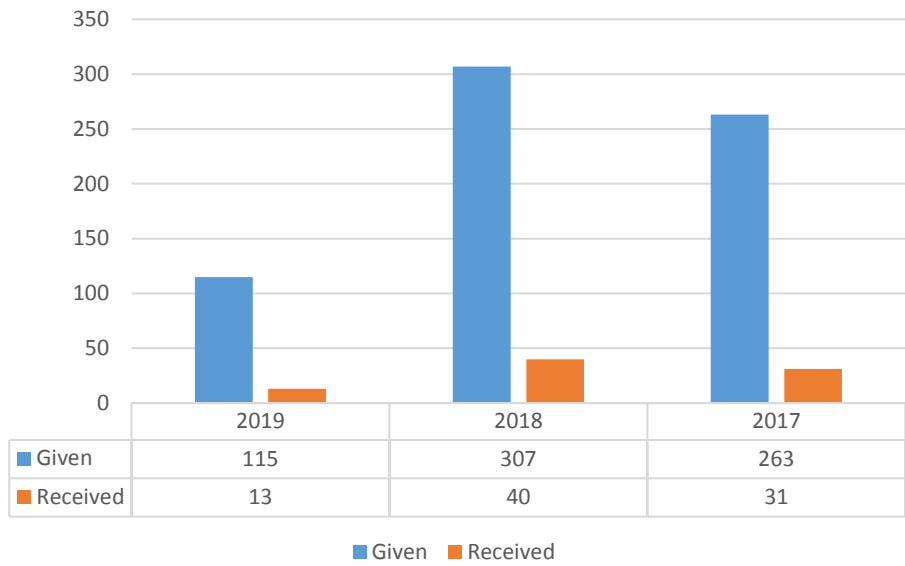
EMS Transport Fees Collected by Month



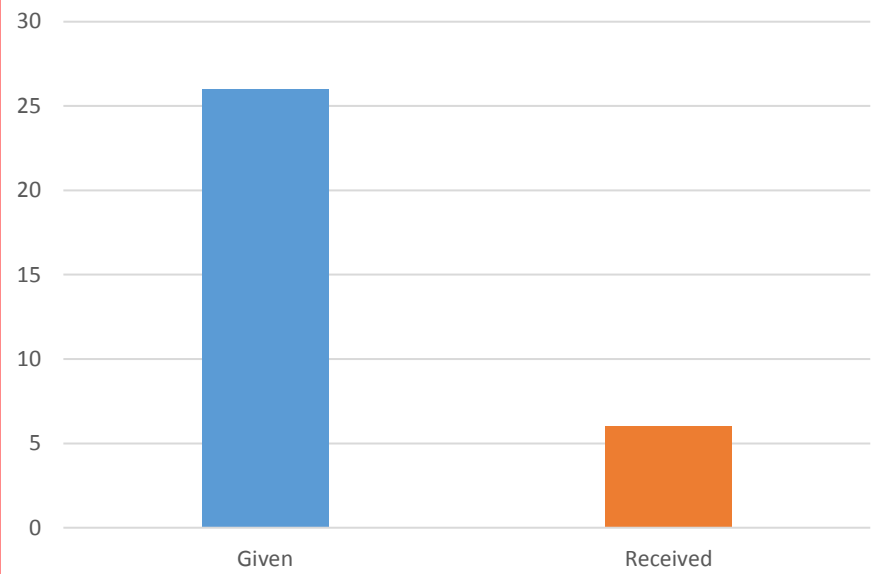
Incident Type by Year
