- ✓ The quality of life is high in Snoqualmie, and the parks system in the city is well rated
- ✓ There is strong support for expanding the community center

- ✓ There is a desire for a pool in Snoqualmie (A lap0 pool in particular that can be used for lessons as well as competitions is appealing and there is far less interest in partnering with Si View to build a larger facility in North Bend)
- ✓ Discussion how else fund might be used, if not for the community center expansion does not dampen enthusiasm for the expansion
- ✓ While subsidizing entry fees is prioritized in the abstract, opinions are split when asked directly if they would be willing to pay more to subsidize membership fees
