Dear Snoqualmie Residents, Business Owners, and Property Owners:

You are receiving this letter because the property you live in, operate a business at, and/or own, is located within the 100-year floodplain of the Snoqualmie River. The City of Snoqualmie works with the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) to reduce property damage, personal injuries, and economic damage from flooding through the Community Rating System (CRS) program. CRS aims to reduce flood losses and educate residents on flood hazards through community activities and programs that go above and beyond the basic minimum requirements of FEMA's National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP). The City's participation in the CRS program ensures that residents and business owners in Snoqualmie enjoy lower flood insurance premiums.

The City completes an annual report to FEMA about the City's progress in meeting NFIP and CRS objectives and requirements. This report is called the Annual Progress Report for the City of Snoqualmie Floodplain Management and Repetitive Loss Plan. This report is compiled every year. The City is providing several opportunities for public comment on the draft Annual Progress Report.
